- Please make sure that no leaves or grass clippings are pushed/blown into the street! This is against village ordinance and fines can be given.
- Each person is responsible for keeping the sidewalk in front of their residence clean and free of any debris.
- If you need a place to dump your leaves there is a pile behind the Village Shop, make sure that LEAVES ONLY are placed in the pile. No bags or garbage.
- There is a brush pile available for resident use by the Waste Water Treatment Plant. This pile is for BRUSH ONLY!
